

**Offer on the terms of booking, registration, purchase, exchange, refund of  
Tickets and visiting rules of  
International racing series DTM 2020 in Leningrad region**

This public offer (hereinafter – "Offer") is drawn up in accordance with paragraph 2 of article 437 of the Civil code of Russian Federation and is directed to any person who wishes to attend international racing series DTM 2020, including, but not limited to, Ticket Buyer, Ticket Holder, wishing to attend the Event, with Ticket to the Event at hand.

This Offer defines the conditions of booking, registration, purchase, exchange, refund of Ticket, as well as rights and obligations of Ticket Holder.

Buyer / Ticket Holder is strongly advised to read and inform themselves about the terms of this Offer. By the fact of attending the Event, staying in the Parking Lot, buying a Ticket, each Buyer/Ticket Holder by default accepts the terms of this Offer and agrees that all the terms of this Offer and any related obligations are binding.

The terms and conditions of this Offer are available on the Official Website of the Event (<https://dtm.igora.drive.ru>), at Official Ticket Offices (indicated on the Official Website of the Event).

1. DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATION

1.1. For the purpose of literal interpretation of this Offer the following definitions are set:

“Offer Terms and Conditions” means the terms and conditions, set out in this Offer that can be amended or modified from time to time, including but not limited to by publications on the Official Website of the Event [www.dtm.igora.drive.ru](http://www.dtm.igora.drive.ru).

“Event Ticket Customer” means an individual and/or an entity who has applied to the Promoter or an entity representing the Promoter’s interests to purchase, get issued, exchange, get a refund for and/or get re-issued a lost or stolen Event Ticket.

“Event Ticket Holder” means a person in possession of a valid Event Ticket to enter the Venue, including an Event Ticket Customer.

“Event Ticket Purchase Confirmation Customer” means an individual and/or entity who has applied to the Promoter or an entity representing the Promoter’s interests to purchase, get issued, exchange or get a refund for an Event Ticket Purchase Confirmation.

“Event Ticket Purchase Confirmation Holder” means a person in possession of a valid Event Ticket Purchase Confirmation, including an Event Ticket Purchase Confirmation Customer.

“Parking Permit Customer” means an individual who has applied to the Promoter or an entity representing the Promoter’s interests to purchase or get a refund for a Parking Permit.

“Parking Permit Holder” means a person in possession of a valid Parking Permit, including a Parking Permit Customer.

“Ticket Product” means an Event Ticket, a Gift Certificate, a Parking Permit, an Electronic Ticket.

“Event Ticket” means a document containing the compulsory details (conditions) set by the current law of the Russian Federation and a unique barcode, certifying the right of the Event Ticket Holder or any other person presenting the Event Ticket, to attend the Event.

“Parking Permit” means a document with a unique serial number, which confirms the right of the Parking Permit Holder to park in the unguarded parking areas, specified on the Official Website of the Event, specifically: entry, exit and parking of a vehicle from 7:00 a.m. till 23:00 p.m. over the period from 29 to 31 May 2020.

"Ticket category for mobility impaired persons" - a document giving the right to attend the Event to disabled people of the first and second category.

«Event» – international DTM 2020 racing series, as well as training, qualifying events and events preceding the stage of the championship DTM 2020 (Stage of the Russian series of circuit races, "touring" class (stage SMP RSKG, "Touring" class), Stage of the Russian series of circuit races, "Granturizmo" class (Stage SMP RSKG, glass GT4), International series, "W" ring race (championship of W Series), which will be held at IGORA DRIVE autodrome with an address at: Leningrad region, Priozersky municipal district, Sosnovsky rural settlement, Novozhilovo village, in the period from 29 to 31 May 2020.

Stage of the Russian series of circuit races, "Touring" class (Stage SMP RSKG, class " Touring»)

Stage of the Russian series of circuit races, "Granturizmo " class (Stage SMP RSKG, GT4)

International series, "W" circuit races (W Series championship)

"Organizer" – limited liability Company "Igora Drive "("Igora Drive" LLC), INN 7801321150, OGRN 1167847419398, legal address: St. Petersburg, 11-Liniya V.O., 38, letter A, premise 91.

“Event Ticket Face Value” means an amount corresponding to the Event admission fee including 20% VAT set by the Promoter for all parties and indicated in the Event Ticket.

“Parking Permit Face Value” means an amount corresponding to the cost of a Parking Permit, including 20% VAT, for the relevant vehicle set by the Promoter for all third parties.

“Official Website of the Event” means a combination of information resources located on the Internet at [www.dtm.drive.igora.ru](http://www.dtm.drive.igora.ru) and published by the Promoter for

general public with the purpose of providing actual and accurate information on the Event.

“Venue” means the circuit for automobile road races of DTM series and infrastructure facilities that ensure its operation, which belongs to the Promoter, as well as all areas in, around and within the circuit, which are used in any manner connected with the holding of the INTERNATIONAL RACE SERIES DTM 2020 and/or are intended for other supporting events.

“Parking” means a special open unguarded [site](#), located in the areas, specified on the Official Website of the Event, which is intended for temporary parking of vehicles of Parking Permit Holders from 7:00 to 23:00 over the period from 29 to 31 May 2019 inc.

“Vehicle” means a category B vehicle (a car) and/or a vehicle, which length exceeds 5 meters and passenger capacity exceeds 8 people (a bus).

“Passenger” means a person, which is or was inside a vehicle in the Car Park, apart from the Parking Permit Holder.

“Force Majeure” means extraordinary, unavoidable circumstances under the given conditions such as natural disasters, military actions, etc.

## 2. GENERAL TERMS

2.1. In the event of adverse weather conditions, the Event may be cancelled in full and / or part of the Event may be postponed or cancelled, at the discretion of the Organizer. Information on the cancellation or postponement of the Event or part thereof shall be published by the Organizer on the official website of the Event.

2.2. Each event Ticket Holder is aware, agrees, accepts and acknowledges that the Event Venue is a dangerous place, some events and events related to the Event are dangerous and there is a possibility of accidents. By attending the Event, passing and / or being present at the Event Site or Parking lot, each Ticket Holder / Passenger accepts this Offer by default and confirms his / her acceptance of all relevant risks and obligations. Each Ticket Holder / Passenger is warned of the possibility of an accident that could cause injury, death, damage or loss of property, and the Ticket Holder / Passenger assumes the sole risk of attending the Event, passing or being present at the Event Site, Parking. Each Ticket Holder / Passenger acknowledges the risks associated with attending or participating in the Event, passing and / or attending the Event Site, Parking, which includes the risk of injury as a result of collision of cars (or parts of cars) with other cars, persons or property. Each Ticket Holder/Passenger agrees, acknowledges and accepts that attending the Event, passing and / or attending The Event Site, Parking Lot is to certain extent dangerous, and hereby releases the Organizer and / or Related legal entities as a whole and individually from any kind of liability, damages or any other costs incurred by the Ticket Holder/Passenger as a result of injury or death, to the extent provided by the

legislation of Russian Federation. Ticket Holder is also responsible for Ticket Holders/Passengers under 18 years of age under his care and present at the Event / Parking lot.

2.3. The Organizer reserves the right to change the Parking Lot for Parking Permit Holders to another Parking if the designated Parking is not available.

2.4. Official merchandise is on sale inside the Venue. Ticket Product Holders/Passengers must not purchase any products from unofficial vendors. No goods (including literature) of any nature may be offered either free or for sale by any person within the Venue or any official Car Park by any party, which does not have a proper permit to do so.

2.5. Save for official merchandise and other motor sport related clothing worn in good faith, it is forbidden to bring into, use or display within the Venue or a Car Park any sponsorship, promotional or marketing materials.

2.6. Where available, the Promoter will provide mobility impaired individuals (wheelchair users), which hold Event Tickets, with appropriate accessible seating for the Event, subject to availability.

2.7. Some areas at the Venue and the Car Parks are exposed to direct sunlight, rain and wind. Each Event Ticket and/or Parking Permit Holder/Passenger should take appropriate care for their well-being and protection from such weather conditions.

2.8. While at the Venue or in a Car Park, the Event Ticket and/or Parking Permit Holder/Passenger must maintain safe, prudent and respectful behaviour and comply with all security measures and instructions given by the Promoter or any other entities acting with the consent of the Promoter.

2.9. Description of the Event, its date, time and location, the Ticket Product prices are available on the Official Website of the Event in the section dedicated to the Event.

2.10. Children under 6 (six) are granted free access to the Event. However, children under 6 (six) cannot occupy a separate seat without a separate Event Ticket purchased. In order to confirm that a child is under 6 (six) so that he/she can be granted free admission to the Event, adults (next of kin or guardians) accompanying a child who is under 6 (six) shall present the child's Birth Certificate upon entry to the Event.

2.11. For children from 6 (six) years to 12 (twelve) years, the Organizer provides the opportunity to entry to the Event within access perimeter of Category 2. To confirm the age adults (close relatives, supporters) with children under 12 (twelve) years old must present a birth certificate of the child or other document with a photo confirming the age of the child when entering the Event.

2.12. Only people older than 14 years old are allowed to the start grid.

2.13. A ticket to the event for an accompanying person with a disability of the first or second category can not be sold separately from the Ticket of mobility impaired person category.

2.14. Parking permit grants Parking Permit Holder / Passenger access to Parking solely for Vehicle Parking purposes. The Parking permit is valid only for the period indicated on it, however, if the event schedule is changed, the validity of the Parking Permit may be changed. The Parking permit does not give right to attend the Event.

### 3. VALIDITY OF THE OFFER

3.1. This Offer shall be valid until 31 May 2020 inclusively.

3.2. Time period for the sale of Tickets for the Event and Parking Permits – up to 7 p.m. May 31 2020 inclusively.

### 4. PERSONAL DATA

4.1. In accordance with the Federal Law from 27.07.2006 № 152-FZ "On personal data", accepting this Offer (entering into the contract), Ticket Buyer agrees that his personal data become publicly available when Ticket Buyer provides his personal data, by indicating them on the Official website of the Event or other Internet resource specified on the Official website of the Event, or otherwise (in Official Ticket offices, call center operators, etc.).

The organizer has the right to use publicly available personal data of the Ticket Buyer for marketing and other purposes in order to fulfill obligations to the Ticket Buyer in accordance with this Offer.

Provisions of this paragraph shall apply in full to Ticket Buyers who are not citizens of European Union. In respect of Ticket Buyers who are citizens of European Union, provisions of this paragraph shall apply to the extent not inconsistent with the provisions of General Data Protection Regulation.

### 5. RESPONSIBILITY OF PARTIES

5.1. The Parties shall be liable for non-performance or improper performance of the terms of this Offer in accordance with legislation of the Russian Federation.

5.2. The Organizer is not responsible for providing sufficient number of Ticket products of all price categories above the established capacity of Event site.

5.3. The Organizer is not responsible for non-compliance of the Event with the personal expectations of Ticket Holder for the Event.

5.4. The Organizer shall not be liable and shall not reimburse the Ticket Buyer any losses for failures arising from problems in the operation of the Ticket system or temporary lack of connection to the Ticket system, which do not allow the Ticket Buyer to make a purchase.

5.5. The Ticket buyer assumes all responsibility according to the current legislation of Russian Federation for the consequences resulting from providing inaccurate or false information to the Organizer or a third party representing the interests of the Organizer, as well as for violation of the rights and interests of other persons as a result of such action.

5.6. The parties shall not be liable for non-performance or improper performance of the terms of the Offer caused by force majeure.

5.7. The Buyer / Ticket Holder may not, without written consent of the Organizer, resell, transfer (for commercial or other personal gain) or distribute any Ticket product(s) (above the Face value indicated on the Ticket product) or through a seller who is not the Organizer or an authorized Ticket Operator.

5.8. The Organizer is not responsible for stolen or counterfeit Ticket products purchased or obtained from unauthorized sources. If it turns out that the Ticket Holder is holding a counterfeit Ticket product that has been claimed as lost or stolen, involved Ticket Holder will not be allowed to enter the Event and/or Parking Lot and the Ticket will be cancelled.

5.9. Ticket products may not be used for advertising, promotional or commercial purposes including sweepstakes, competitions, contests or sweepstakes, may not be included in package offers with hospitality products (such as catering, transfers, accommodation, souvenirs, etc.), except those previously approved by the Organizer in writing.

5.10. The organizer reserves the right to refuse entry to the Event Site, Parking Lot (or dismiss from the Event Site, Parking Lot) to the Ticket Holder whose Ticket product was sold or used in violation of the terms of this Offer.

5.11. Attendance of the Event by persons below 18 (eighteen) years old is possible only when accompanied by a legal representative.

5.12. It is forbidden to use the name of the Event or its part (as well as an abbreviation or translation into a foreign language), trademarks of the Organizer, logo or graphic image of the Event or related to the Event for any commercial purposes not agreed with the Organizer.

5.13. The Ticket holder is solely responsible for compliance with all immigration, customs or legal requirements of any relevant authorities for entry into the territory of Russian Federation (including but not limited to obtaining an entry visa or a permit). There is no exchange, refund or replacement of the Ticket for the Event due to failure to obtain (or refusal, cancellation, expiration or revocation) an entry visa or permit for any reason.

5.14. Each Ticket Holder undertakes to indemnify the Organizer and/or Related legal entities for all damages, losses, liabilities or injuries that have been caused as a result of non-compliance by the Ticket Holder and/or Passenger with the terms of this Offer, or intentional, negligent or negligent acts or omissions of the Ticket Holder and / or Passenger or any person under the care or supervision of the Ticket product Owner that occurred at the Event Venue, Parking lot.

5.15. The Parking Permit holder agrees that only Vehicles with a valid Parking Permit may be allowed to Parking Lot.

5.16. The Parking Permit Holder / Passenger agrees that all risks associated with Parking Vehicles (including their contents) in any of the Parking Lots are the responsibility of the Parking Permit Holder/Passenger. The Organizer is not responsible for any loss or damage caused to the Vehicle (including its contents) as a result of the Owner's use of the Parking Permit/Passenger Parking.

5.17. Upon receipt of a Parking Permit, the Parking Permit Holder / Passenger agrees to comply with the rules and conditions established by the Organizer with respect to the Parking lots and the Event Site itself.

5.18. The Ticket holder / Passenger, while in the Parking lot (both in the Vehicle and outside), undertakes to comply with the safety rules, as well as any instructions of the Organizer's staff. The organizer reserves the right to withdraw the Parking Permit and deny access and / or dismiss from the Parking lot any person (s) who violated the terms of the Offer.

5.19. Without prior written consent of the Organizer, the Ticket Holder shall not:

(a) enter the Venue outside the hours of the Event (the opening and closing times of the spectator gates will be published on the official website of the Event);

(b) leave the Event Site, Parking through non-designated exits;

(c) move fences, enter fenced areas or interfere with any activity in any fenced area;

(d) erect any structures or erect, or display signs, banners, etc. at the Event Site and / or Parking Lot;

(e) place, stick or post any poster, banner, printed or any other promotional material on any building, structure, fence, tree or fence at the Event Site or Parking Lot;

(f) distribute printed publications or materials, neither distribute, display or promote any advertising or promotional materials, samples of goods or services, or any other type of products on the Venue and Parking Lot;

(g) distribute, deliver, sell, offer or display for sale any goods or raise money for orders for goods or services on the Venue or in the Parking Lot;

(h) sell, offer or put up for sale any Event Ticket and / or Parking Permit above its Face value stated on the Event Ticket and / or Parking Permit;

(i) improperly use, damage, destroy or change any building, seat, chair, table, structure, vehicle, vessel, truck, pipes, crane, crane mounts, piping, electrical equipment, wiring, or signs on the Event Site and / or Parking Lot;

(j) block access to the Venue, Parking Lot;

(k) leave garbage anywhere apart from specially designed containers;

(l) throw or kick stones, bottles and other objects;

(m) interfere with, interrupt or behave in a manner that may disrupt or interrupt any race, event or activity;

(n) act or behave in a manner that interferes with the activities of the driver of any racing vehicle or adversely affects the safety of spectators;

(o) use obscene or unquotable language, threatening or abusive words, or behave in any other threatening, violent, obscene or offensive manner;

(p) use a loudspeaker, warning system, broadcasting device or other device that may interfere with the operation of electronic or radio communication devices used by the Organizer, participants of the Event, other persons authorized by the Organizer;

(q) Smoking in undesignated areas;

(r) to pass to a tribune or to a zone of free attendance with drinks in plastic, glass or tin containers (of any volume), except plastic or paper glasses got in the specialized outlets located in the Venue.

5.20. The Promoter and agencies ensuring the safety of the Venue and the Car Parks reserve the right to move any Vehicle they deem necessary for the reasons of safety of the Venue and the Car Parks or for any similar reasons..

5.21. An Event Ticket Holder shall have the right to attend the Event on the days specified in his/her Event Ticket. And the attendance of one day of the Event shall be deemed to be the attendance of the entire Event subject to the Promoter not being at fault.

5.22. On the day of the Event one Event Ticket is valid for one person only. Event Ticket transfer to another person throughout the day of the Event is prohibited .

5.23. One Parking Permit allows only one Vehicle of a certain category, indicated in the Parking Permit (either a car or a bus) into the Car Park. During the whole day, it is prohibited to hand over the same Parking Permit to be used by another Vehicle to access the Car Park.

5.24. A Ticket Product Customer can buy not more than 10 (ten) Ticket Products. In case of exceeding the limit the Promoter shall be entitled to cancel all the Ticket Products that exceed the limit specified in this Clause, with no compensation of their cost. The number of Ticket Products to be sold may be increased by an agreement between the Ticket Product Customer and the Promoter.

5.25. The right to visit the concert gives Ticket for two days (weekend) of category 1 or 2, and the ticket for May 30 2020 of category 1 or 2. The Ticket for May 29 or 31 2020 does not give the right to visit the concert.

## 6. DISTRIBUTION OF EVENT INFORMATION

6.1. By accepting this Offer, a Ticket Product Customer agrees that the Promoter or any third party acting with consent of the Promoter, may regularly distribute information, regarding the Event and/or any other Promoter's offers, to the e-mail address and/or mobile phone number, indicated by the Ticket Product Customer while purchasing the Ticket Product.

6.2. The volume and content of the information distributed as well as the dates and time of the distribution shall be established by the Promoter at its absolute discretion.



6.3. A Ticket Product Customer shall have the right, at any time to opt out of such communications by sending an email notification to the Promoter according to the instructions, contained in the corresponding letter (newsletter).

6.4. The provisions of clauses 6.1. to 6.3. of this Offer shall fully apply to the Ticket Product Customers who are not EU citizens. The provisions of this clause shall apply to the Ticket Product Customers who are EU citizens to the extent that they are not in conflict with the provisions of the General Data Protection Regulation

## 7. ADDITIONAL SERVICES

7.1. The Promoter or a third party acting with the permission of the Promoter shall have the right to charge a Ticket Product Customer Additional Payments related to the delivery of the Ticket Product, acquiring, including Visa and/or MasterCard payments and services associated with the purchase of the Ticket Product. The Ticket Product Customer confirms the acceptance of such Additional Payments (indicated on the Official Website of the Event or other Internet resource specified on the Official Website of the Event, in the Official Ticket Offices or the call centre) when completing the order.

## 8. SPECIAL CONDITIONS

8.1. A Ticket Product Holder must not make, create, store, record or transmit any kind of sound recording, visual footage, audio-visual footage (further - Recording), as well as store, record or transmit any information or other data, including official timing, results, performance, telemetry, weather or race control data (further - Data) of, at or in relation to the Event. It is forbidden to bring into the Venue any equipment that may enable the visitor to perform the aforementioned acts. Personal electronic devices (including still image cameras, mobile telephones and other handheld personal communication devices) are permitted within the Venue unless otherwise advised, provided that any Recording, Data and any image, including photographic images and any still pictures derived or capable of being derived from a Recording (further - Image) of the Event, recorded, stored and/or created at the Event are used for personal and non-commercial purposes only, which does not include social media

8.2. Each Ticket Product Holder hereby agrees that:

- (a) the Ticket Product Holder can be held liable for any use of such Recordings, Data and Images, listed in Clause 8.1. of the Offer for advertising, commercial or other purposes (except for private viewing) without a prior written consent of Promoter;
- (b) upon the request of the Promoter, Ticket Product Holder shall assign to him in writing the copyright and all other intellectual property rights in any Image or

Recording that a Ticket Product Holder creates, makes, stores or records of, at or in relation to the Event;

(c) Promoter may use for the purposes of or in connection with any publication, exhibition or broadcast (including any advertising or promotional literature, campaign or material) in any media worldwide any still or moving picture images taken at the Event where such image includes any image of the Ticket Product Holder and/or Passenger and the Ticket Product Holder/Passenger waives any and all of his or her personality and privacy rights to the extent necessary to permit such use.

8.3. The Event Promoter reserves the right to refuse admission to the Venue and/or a Car Park (or eject from the Event/a Car Park) any Ticket Product Holder who violates the obligations listed in Resolution of the Government of the Russian Federation dated 16 December 2013 No. 1156 “On Adoption of Code of Conduct for Spectators at Official Sporting Events”.

8.4. The Ticket Product Holder hereby confirms that motor racing, the Event and certain activities associated therewith (including but not limited to the support events) are dangerous. The Promoter, sanctioning bodies, persons involved in the organisation of the Event (including officials, marshals, rescue and medical staff), the competitors and drivers (such parties to include where relevant all directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors and affiliated companies), are not responsible for any loss or damage howsoever caused to the Event Ticket Holder or property of the Event Ticket Holder to the maximum extent permitted by the law of the Russian Federation (save that nothing in these conditions limits or excludes (a) liability for death or personal injury arising out of the negligence of any of the above mentioned parties, or (b) any damage incurred by way of fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation by any of the above mentioned parties).

8.5. During the Event the noise level may be very high. It is advised to wear hearing protection during the Event to reduce the risk of hearing damage.

8.6. The Ticket Product Holder acknowledges and accepts that some seats may have restricted viewing or legroom and that natural or man-made obstructions in some areas may impede viewing. The Promoter reserves the right at its discretion to issue last minute changes to seating arrangements, which may result in a Ticket Product Holder being moved to a seat with an obstructed view or restricted legroom. Should the Promoter issue any significant changes, the Promoter will notify the Ticket Product Customer directly of such changes and endeavour to provide alternative seating arrangements.

8.7. Ticket Products purchased, sold or used in violation of the terms and conditions of this Offer will be deemed void and may result in the following:

- (a) denial of entry to the Venue/a Car Park;
- (b) ejection from the Venue/a Car Park;
- (c) cancellation of the Ticket Product with no refund

## 9.EVENT TICKET AND PARKING PERMITS REFUND AND REPLACEMENT PROCEDURE

9.1. An Event Ticket and/or Parking Permit Customer may request Event Ticket and/or Parking Permit refund in the following cases:

- (a) Cancellation of the Event.
- (b) Death of the Event Ticket and/or Parking Permit Holder.
- (c) Sickness of the Event Ticket and/or Parking Permit Holder not allowing him or her to attend the Event and/or use the Parking Permit for medical reasons.
- (d) In any other cases provided for by the law of the Russian Federation.

9.2. Only the Face Value of purchased Event Tickets and/or Parking Permits can be refunded.

9.3. Additional Payments will not be refunded in case of an Event Ticket Purchase Confirmation/Event Ticket and/or Parking Permit refund on the grounds provided for in Sub-clauses b to d Clause 9.1. of this Offer.

9.4. To refund the cost of the Ticket and/or Parking Permit, the Customer shall contact the Official ticket offices of the Ticket Operator (the list of which is given on the Ticket website [www.kassir.ru](http://www.kassir.ru)), or send an application for the return of The ticket to the Event and / or Parking Permit to the Official ticket operator KASSIR.RU LLC no later than May 15, 2020 by e-mail [info@dtm.igora.drive.ru](mailto:info@dtm.igora.drive.ru) not later than May 28, 2020 (in case of purchase of an electronic ticket).

A sample application for a refund of the Event Ticket and / or Parking Permit is posted on the official website of the Event and is available at the Official Ticket offices. The application must specify the details of the current account, which is subject to transfer funds for the return of Confirmation of the purchase of a Ticket and / or Parking Permit. All the fields of the application for the return of the Event Ticket and / or Parking Permit must be filled in.

The application for a refund of the Ticket and / or Parking Permit must be accompanied by:

- original ticket for the Event and / or Parking Permit in case of purchase at the Official Ticket offices, in case of purchase of electronic electronic Ticket for the Event – printed electronic Ticket,
- a copy of the passport, in case of return of the Ticket and / or Parking Permit under the conditions specified in the PP. (b) and (c) clause 9.1. of the Offer
- documents confirming the fact of death or illness of the Customer of the Ticket and / or Parking Permit.

9.5. In case of approval of Event Ticket and/or Parking Permit refund, the money shall be transferred to the Customer as follows:

- in case of non-cash payment (bank card) the refund will be made to the bank account, which was used for purchasing the Event Ticket;

- in case of cash payment for the Event Ticket the refund will be made to the bank account which Customer indicates in the relevant refund request form or in cash (in case relevant amount is available at the ticket office).

The refund is processed within 10 (ten) calendar days of the receipt of a refund request and all the necessary documents and information by the Promoter.

9.6. The Promoter reserves the right to deny the refund of the Event Ticket if the Ticket was purchased in violation of the terms and conditions of the Offer.

9.7. An Event Ticket and/or Parking Permit Holder must keep their Event Ticket and/or Parking Permit safe, as the Event Ticket and/or Parking Permit will not be re-issued if it is lost or stolen. A defaced or illegible Event Ticket and/or Parking Permit may also be deemed invalid.

9.8. In case the Promoter agrees to re-issue a stolen or lost Event Ticket, the Promoter reserves the right to charge the Event Ticket Holder a fee for the re-issue of the Event Ticket.

9.9. Parking Permits cannot be re-issued or exchanged under any circumstances.

## 10. EVENT SAFETY

10.1. In order to ensure public safety, the Promoter reserves the right to ask a Ticket Product Holder/Passenger to leave the Event/Car Park at any moment for security reasons. Access to the Venue is forbidden after the end of the Event.

10.2. To ensure security whilst at the Venue, CCTV cameras will be used. A Ticket Product Customer/Holder agrees that footage taken of him/her for general security measures may be used for the purposes of general security or passed to the parties ensuring security at the Venue/in the Car Park for it to be used in any proceedings.

10.3. To ensure safety whilst at the Venue/in the Car Park security companies engaged by the Promoter have the right to search any person entering the Venue/any Vehicle entering a Car Park and any of his/her belongings/items inside the Vehicle without providing any reasons. The Promoter also has the right to refuse entry to the Venue/Car Park for any person/Vehicle or to eject from the Venue/Car Park any person/Vehicle refusing to submit to search. No refund of the Event Ticket cost and/or Parking Permit cost will be made in this case.

10.4. No animals will be admitted to the Venue or any Car Park, except guide dogs

10.5. While at the Venue, the Event Ticket Holders must always keep to the designated paths and access all free-standing viewing areas with caution, using steps or path as appropriate.

10.6. While in the Car Park, Parking Permit Holders shall follow special signage, markings and proceed with caution when entering the Car Park and driving inside it.

10.7. An Event Ticket Holder cannot bring into the Venue and use the following items:

(a) weapons of any type including self-defence weapons, ammunition, bladed

articles, any other items that might be used as a weapon, explosives, poisonous, toxic or odorous substances, radioactive materials;

(b) flammable and pyrotechnical substances or articles, (except for matches, pocket lighters), including air-horns, flares, fireworks, gas tanks, and any other items (chemicals) that might be used for production of pyrotechnic products or smokes;

(c) other substances, items, articles, including self-made that can be used to produce smoke or fire, self-igniting liquids;

(d) tools and articles including self-made that are not pyrotechnical and that are used for dispersion or diffusion of different substances (pneumatic crackers);

(e) any flag or banner with dimensions exceeding 2.0 x 1.5 m, including those with hollow flagpoles with flagpoles' length exceeding 1.5 m and flagpoles' diameter exceeding 2.5 cm, chairs, benches, stools, ice chests, helium filled balloons, balls of any type and size;

(f) colourants;

(g) wind instruments to produce sounds (including vuvuzelas and whistles), except for bugles and pipes;

(h) alcoholic and non-alcoholic drinks of any kind, except for soft drinks in plastic containers with the volume not exceeding 0.5 litres, glass bottles or containers, food, except for baby food with the volume not exceeding 1 litre per baby (including soy milk, breast milk or cow's milk, infant formulas and sterilized water, including those in glass containers, any other food, required for feeding children under 5 years of age).

Adults carrying baby food may be asked to present it for inspection;

(i) narcotics, toxics or stimulants;

(j) promotional extremist materials; materials containing Nazi or extremist symbols or attributes;

(k) technical equipment which can interfere with the staging of the Event or with its participants (laser devices, flashlights), radios, sound amplification tools;

(l) bulky items that create inconvenience for other spectators, except with the consent of the Promoter to bring such items;

(m) domestic animals (except for guide dogs supporting a Ticket Product Holder with a disability);

(n) bicycles, scooters, skateboards and roller blades, fireworks, Frisbees, musical instruments and (or) musical equipment, including alarm systems, sirens, whistles, electronic equipment or any other broadcast equipment;

(o) kick scooters, including two- or three-wheeled, self-balancing electric vehicles (e.g. Segway);

(p) suitcases or bags with the dimensions exceeding 40 x 40 x 45cm.

## 11. DISPUTE RESOLUTION PROCEDURE

11.1. Any dispute arising out of the explanation or implementation of this Offer will be resolved by the Parties by sending a complaint to the other Party. The complaint shall be considered within 10 working days of its receipt.

11.2. If the Parties do not reach an agreement, the dispute will be settled in court in the established manner.

## 12. FINAL PROVISIONS

12.1. This Offer comes into force and effect upon being published on the Official Website of the Event or other Internet site, specified on the Official Website of the Event and is valid until 31 May 2020 inclusive.

12.2. The Promoter has the right to change this Offer at any time, but all changes shall be published and brought to public attention by publication on the Official Website of the Event. Changes to the Offer do not have a retroactive effect, which means they are not applicable to civil law relations that emerged before the publication of the changes.

12.3. The Promoter has the right to terminate the Offer at any time without prior notice to the Ticket Product Customer/Holder in case of violation of the terms and conditions of the Offer by the latter.

12.4. The amendments or variations of this Offer are only valid and binding if made or confirmed by the Promoter by publishing a notice on the Official Website of the Event.

12.5. Each of the provisions of this Offer is severable from any other. If any provision or part of a provision is or becomes invalid, unenforceable or illegal in any respect, such provision or part of such provision will be deemed invalid and will be deemed not to form part of this Offer. The remaining provisions or parts of such provisions will not be deemed invalid.

12.6. The terms and conditions of this Offer have been drawn up in Russian and English languages. In the event of any inconsistency between Russian and English versions, Russian version of the Offer shall prevail.

12.7. The terms and conditions of this Offer are governed by, construed and enforced in all respects in accordance with the law of Russian Federation.
